As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, you should know that a public hearing will be held by the Planning Commission to consider an application for a Conditional Use Permit, amendment to Conditional Use Permit No. 183194 for the extension of the mining operation use and related activities, located at 2499 Qualcomm Way. The 11-acre site within the Quarry Falls Specific Plan area is located in the EMX-1 zone within the Mission Valley Community Plan area.

This project is within the scope of Program Environmental Impact Report Number49068 / SCH 2005081018, Certified on October 21, 2008. This Program Environmental Impact Report adequately describes the activity for the purposes of CEQA. A consistency evaluation was prepared to determine if conditions specified in California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Statute and Guidelines, Section 15162 would require preparation of additional CEQA review for the project. As outlined in the evaluation, the project is consistent with the original adopted/certified stated above and would not result in new impacts. Based on the CEQA Section 15162 consistency analysis, the project would not require any additional environmental review.

#### APPEALS:

The decision of the Planning Commission is final unless appealed to the City Council. In order to appeal the decision of the Planning Commission, you must register as a speaker at the public hearing concerning the application or have expressed interest in webform or in writing to the Planning Commission, (https://www.sandiego.gov/planning-commission), before the close of the public hearing. Appeal procedures are described in Information Bulletin 505 (https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505). The appeal must be made no later than ten (10) business days after the date of the Planning Commission's decision. If you wish to challenge the City's action on the above proceedings in court, you may be limited to addressing only those issues you or someone else have raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or written in correspondence to the City at or before the public hearing. The decision of the City Council is final. Appeals to the City Clerk may be filed by e-mail or in person as follows:

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked within 5 business days of the date the appeal is filed.

2) Appeals filed in person: Bring the fully completed appeal application <u>DS-3031</u> (<u>https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/legacy/development-services/pdf/industry/forms/ds3031.pdf</u>) (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building—Public Information Counter, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Lobby, (Open 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday – excluding Cityapproved holidays) located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00 PM on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.
