As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, you should know that a public hearing will be held by the Planning Commission on an application for a Conditional Use Permit for a Wireless Communication Facility that consists of nine (9) additional antennas for a total of twelve (12) antennas and six (6) additional Remote Radio Units (RRUs) for a total of 15 RRUs concealed behind existing Fiberglass Reinforced Panel (FRP) decorative screens on an existing 48′ 7″ tall cupola and; a 170-square foot ground level equipment enclosure. The site is in the RS-1-7 zone located at 1502 Via Las Cumbres University of San Diego campus.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines, Section 15302 (Replacement Existing Structures) on March 1, 2024, and the opportunity to appeal that determination ended March 15, 2024.

### **APPEALS**:

The decision of the Planning Commission is final unless appealed to the City Council. In order to appeal the decision of the Planning Commission, you must register as a speaker at the public hearing concerning the application or have expressed interest in webform or in writing to the Planning Commission, (<a href="https://www.sandiego.gov/planning-commission">https://www.sandiego.gov/planning-commission</a>), before the close of the public hearing. Appeal procedures are described in <a href="https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505">https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505</a>). The appeal must

be made no later than ten (10) business days after the date of the Planning Commission's decision. If you wish to challenge the City's action on the above proceedings in court, you may be limited to addressing only those issues you or someone else have raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or written in correspondence to the City at or before the public hearing. The decision of the City Council is final. Appeals to the City Clerk may be filed by e-mail or in person as follows:

- 1) Appeals filed via e-mail/mail: Send the fully completed appeal application DS-3031 (https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/legacy/development-services/pdf/industry/forms/ds3031.pdf) (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation in pdf format) via e-mail to Hearings1@sandiego.gov by 5:00 PM on or before the last day of the appeal period; your e-mail appeal will be acknowledged within 24 hours. You must separately mail the appeal fee by check payable to the City Treasurer to: City Clerk/Appeal, MS 2A, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101. The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked within 5 business days of the date the appeal is filed.
- 2) Appeals filed in person: Bring the fully completed appeal application <u>DS-3031</u> (<a href="https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/legacy/development-services/pdf/industry/forms/ds3031.pdf">https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/legacy/development-services/pdf/industry/forms/ds3031.pdf</a>) (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building—Public Information Counter, 1st Floor Lobby, (Open 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday excluding Cityapproved holidays) located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00 PM on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.
