As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, you should know that a public hearing will be held by the Hearing Officer to consider an application for a Site Development Permit for a 117,510-square-foot, two-story self-storage building with a basement, leasing office and associated site improvements. The 1.70-acre site is located at the southwest corner of Princess View Drive and Mission Gorge Road (Assessor's Parcel Numbers: 455-040-38-00 and 455-040-39-00) in the Industrial-Light IL-2-1 zone, Prime Industrial Lands, the Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (ALUCOZ) for Montgomery Field, Community Plan Implementation Overlay Zone Type A (CPIOZ-A), the Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) and Airport Influence Area (AIA) for Montgomery Field – Review Area 2, the Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone (VHFSZ) and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Part 77 Noticing Area within the Navajo Community Plan area.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15332 (In-Fill Development Projects) on October 2, 2023, and the opportunity to appeal that determination ended October 16, 2023.

**APPEAL OF THE HEARING OFFICER DECISION:** The decision of the Hearing Officer is final unless appealed to the Planning Commission. The decision made by the Planning Commission is the final decision by the City. In order to appeal the decision, you must be registered as a speaker at the public hearing concerning the application or have expressed interest by writing to the Hearing Officer, HearingOfficer@sandiego.gov before the close of the public hearing. Appeal procedures are described in Information Bulletin 505 (https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505). "Appeal" and must include the required appeal fee per Information Bulletin 505 in the form of a check
payable to the City Treasurer. This safe is checked daily, and payments are processed the following
business day. All payments must be in the exact amount, drawn on US banks, and be made out to "City
Treasurer." Please include in the memo of the check the invoice number or Project number or attach
