As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, you should know that a public hearing will be held by the Hearing Officer to consider an application for a Variance and a Public Service Easement Vacation for a new 141,450-square-foot, two-story self-storage building with a full basement located at 5150 University Avenue in the City Heights neighborhood of the Mid-City Communities Plan.

APPEAL OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT: The certification of an Environmental Impact Report, or adoption of a Mitigated Negative Declaration or Negative Declaration, may be appealed to the City Council. All such appeals must be filed by 5:00 PM within ten (10) business days from the date of the Hearing Officer's certification/adoption of the environmental document. Appeal procedures are described in <u>Information Bulletin 505</u> (https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505). Appeals to the City Clerk must be filed by email or in person at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101 as follows:

1) <u>Appeals filed via E-mail</u>: The Environmental Determination Appeal Application Form <u>DS-3031</u>can be obtained at (https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/legacy/development-services/pdf/industry/forms/ds3031). Send the completed appeal form (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation in pdf format) by email to Hearings1@sandiego.gov by 5:00 PM on the last day of the appeal period; your email appeal will be acknowledged within 24 business hours. You must separately mail the appeal fee by check payable to the

City Treasurer to: City Clerk/Appeal, MS 2A, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101. The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked before or on the final date of the appeal. Please include the project number on the memo line of the check.

2) Appeals filed in person: Environmental Determination Appeal Application Form <u>DS-3031</u> can be obtained at (https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/legacy/development-services/pdf/industry/forms/ds3031.pdf). Bring the fully completed appeal application DS-3031 (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building—Public Information Counter (Open 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday excluding City-approved holidays), 1st Floor Lobby, located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00 PM on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.

APPEAL OF THE HEARING OFFICER DECISION: The decision of the Hearing Officer is final unless appealed to the City Council pursuant to SDMC Sections 112.0103 and 125.1030(b). In order to appeal the decision of the Hearing Officer, you must register as a speaker at the public hearing concerning the application or have expressed interest via webform or in writing to the Hearing Officer, HearingOfficer@sandiego.gov, before the close of the public hearing. Appeal procedures are described in Information Bulletin 505 (https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505). The appeal must be made no later than ten (10) business days after the date of the Hearing Officer's decision. If you wish to challenge the City's action on the above proceedings in court, you may be limited to addressing only those issues you or someone else have raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or written in correspondence to the City at or before the public hearing. The decision of the City Council is final. Appeals to the City Clerk may be filed by e-mail or in person as follows:

The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.
