As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to approve, conditionally approve, or deny an application for a Coastal Development Permit and Site Development Permit to amend Coastal Development Permit No. 404174 and Site Development Permit No. 404177 for the boundary adjustment of an existing conservation easement on site containing environmentally sensitive lands. The 0.98-acre site is located on a parcel (APN: 358-130-0800), one lot southwest of 1615 Clemson Circle, west of Rutgers Road in the Residential Single-Unit (RS-1-2) Base Zone, Coastal (Non-Appealable) and Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zones within the La Jolla Community Plan area.

This development is within the Coastal (Non-Appealable) Overlay Zone and the application was filed June 10, 2021.

The final decision by the City of San Diego is not appealable to the California Coastal Commission. If you want to receive a Notice of Final Action, you must submit a written request to the Development Project Manager listed above.

The project site was previously analyzed within the Mitigated Negative Declaration No. 118907/State Clearing House No. 2008101139. On October 19, 2023, where the City conducted a consistency evaluation to determine if the conditions specified in California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Statute and Guidelines, Section 15162 would

require preparation of an additional CEQA review for the project. It was found that the project is consistent with the previously certified and adopted environmental documents and therefore, no subsequent document is required.

APPEALS:

The decision of the Planning Commission is final unless appealed to the City Council. In order to appeal the decision of the Planning Commission, you must register as a speaker at the public hearing concerning the application or have expressed interest in webform or in writing to the Planning Commission, (<https://www.sandiego.gov/planning-commission>), before the close of the public hearing. Appeal procedures are described in [Information Bulletin 505](https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505) (<https://www.sandiego.gov/development-services/forms-publications/information-bulletins/505>). The appeal must be made no later than ten (10) business days after the date of the Planning Commission's decision. If you wish to challenge the City's action on the above proceedings in court, you may be limited to addressing only those issues you or someone else have raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or written in correspondence to the City at or before the public hearing. The decision of the City Council is final. Appeals to the City Clerk may be filed by e-mail or in person as follows:

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked within 5 business days of the date the appeal is filed.
- 2) Appeals filed in person: Bring the fully completed appeal application [DS-3031](https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/legacy/development-services/pdf/industry/forms/ds3031.pdf) (<https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/legacy/development-services/pdf/industry/forms/ds3031.pdf>) (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building—Public Information Counter, 1st Floor Lobby, (Open 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday – excluding City-approved holidays) located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00 PM on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer.
