As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the Hearing Officer will hold a public hearing to approve, conditionally approve, or deny an application for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for an alcoholic beverage outlet in accordance with a Type 21 ABC Liquor License for the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits within an existing 2,400-square-foot market. The 0.23-acre site is located at 3070 Reynard Way in the CN-1-3 (Commercial-Neighborhood) Base Zone in the following overlay zones: Airport Influence Area - Review Area 2 for Naval Air Station (NAS) North Island, and Review Area 1 for San Diego International Airport (SDIA), Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Part 77, Noticing Area for NAS North Island and SDIA, Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) Overlay Zone for SDIA And NAS North Island, ALUCP Noise Contours (CNEL) for San Diego International Airport (SDIA) (60-65 CNEL), Airport Approach Overlay Zone for SDIA, Transit Priority Area (TPA), Parking Standards TPA, Brush Management, Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone; within the Uptown Community Planning area.

**APPEAL OF THE HEARING OFFICER DECISION:** The decision of the Hearing Officer is final unless appealed to the Planning Commission. In order to appeal the decision, you must be registered as a speaker at the public hearing concerning the application or have expressed interest by writing to the Hearing Officer, <u>HearingOfficer@sandiego.gov</u> before the close of the public hearing. Appeal procedures are described in <u>Information Bulletin 505</u> (<u>https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/dsdib505.pdf</u>). Appeals to the Planning Commission can be filed by email/mail or in person:

- 1) Appeals filed via email/mail: Send the fully completed appeal application <u>DS-3031</u> (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation in pdf format) via email to <u>PlanningCommission@sandiego.gov</u> by 4:00pm on the last day of the appeal period. When received by the City, the appellant will be invoiced for payment of the required Appeal Fee. Timely payment of this invoice is required to complete processing of the appeal. Failure to pay the invoice within 5 business days of invoice issuance will invalidate the appeal application.
- 2) Appeals filed in person: Bring the fully completed appeal application <u>DS-3031</u> (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the touchless Payment Drop-Off drop safe in the first-floor lobby of the Development Services Center, located at 1222 First Avenue in Downtown San Diego by 4 p.m. on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal package must be clearly marked on the outside as "Appeal" and must include the required appeal fee per this bulletin in the form of a check payable to the City Treasurer. This safe is checked daily, and payments are processed the following business day. All payments must be in the exact amount, drawn on US banks, and be made out to "City Treasurer." Please include in the memo of the check the invoice # or Project # or attach the invoice to the check. Cash payments are only accepted by appointment; email <u>DSDCashiers@sandiego.gov</u> to schedule an appointment.

The decision made by the Planning Commission is the final decision by the City.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of CEQA State Guidelines on February 21, 2023 and the opportunity to appeal that determination ended March 6, 2023.

## REQUESTS FOR ACCESSIBILITY MODIFICATIONS OR ACCOMMODATIONS
