

CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

Section 18

1. Original Charter section approved by voters April 7, 1931

Section 18. AUTHENTICATION AND PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS. Upon its final passage each ordinance or resolution shall be authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and the City Clerk and shall be recorded in a book kept for that purpose. Within ten days after final passage each ordinance or resolution of a general nature shall be published at least once in such manner as may be provided by this Charter or by ordinance.

Section 18. AUTHENTICATION AND PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS.

Upon its final passage each ordinance or resolution shall be authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and the City Clerk and shall be recorded in a book kept for that purpose. Within fifteen days after final passage each ordinance or resolution of a general nature shall be published at least once in such manner as may be provided by this Charter or by ordinance.
