## Section 96

**1. Original Charter section approved by voters April 7, 1931**

Section 96. PROGRESSIVE PAYMENTS. Any contract may provide for progressive payments if the ordinance or resolution authorizing the work so prescribes, but no progressive payment can be provided for or made at any time which, with prior payments, shall exceed in amount at that time seventy-five per cent of the value of the work done and materials used and no contract shall authorize or permit the payment of more than seventy-five per cent of the contract price before five days after the expiration period of filing liens, and the acceptance thereof by the Head of the Department concerned, and the Manager.

**2. Amendment voted 03-23-1937; effective 04-14-1937**

Section 96. **Progressive Payments.** Any contract may provide for progressive payments if the ordinance or resolution authorizing the work so prescribes, but no progressive payment can be provided for or made at any time which, with prior payments, shall exceed in amount at that time ninety per cent of the value of the work done and materials used and no contract shall authorize or permit the payment of more than ninety per cent of the contract price before five days after the expiration period of filing liens, and the acceptance thereof by the Head of the Department concerned, and the Manager.
