

CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

Section 213

1. Original Charter section approved by voters April 7, 1931

Section 213. CONTINUING IN FORCE ORDINANCES AND CONTRACTS. All ordinances unless expressly repealed by this Charter, ordinances adopted or in pursuance to the powers of this Charter, and all contracts of The City of San Diego in force at the time of the passage of this Charter shall continue in force until amended or repealed.

2. Amendment voted 04-22-1941; effective 05-08-1941

Section 213. CONTINUING IN FORCE ORDINANCES AND CONTRACTS. All ordinances not inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Charter shall continue in force until amended or repealed, and all contracts of The City of San Diego in force at the time of the adoption of this Charter, and not inconsistent with any of the provisions thereof, shall continue in force until completed, amended or rescinded.
