

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 186211

A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE A PORTION OF MISSION AVENUE,

AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Council of The City of San Diego, that the public interest and convenience of said City require the vacation of a portion of the street hereinafter mentioned; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of said Council to order the vacation of a portion of MISSION AVENUE, southeasterly of a line parallel to and 50 feet southeasterly of the westerly curb line, between Madison Avenue and Texas Street,

as more particularly shown on Map No. 10973-B, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 694872.

The Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said vacation, under the provisions of the "Street Vacation Act of 1941."

The Council hereby fixes ^{9:00}~~10:00~~ A.M., MAR 1 - 1966 in the Council Chamber on the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, Community Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.

That the San Diego Union, a daily newspaper published and circulated, and of general circulation, in the said City of San Diego, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, and the said Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by law and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in said newspaper in the manner required by law.
