

RESOLUTION NO. 186313

APPROVING MAP OF TELSTAR SUBDIVISION AND  
ACCEPTING ON BEHALF OF THE PUBLIC PORTIONS  
OF PUBLIC STREETS DEDICATED ON SAID MAP  
WITHIN THIS SUBDIVISION.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
as follows:

Said Council hereby finds that that certain map surveyed  
by BYRL D. PHELPS, Registered Civil Engineer, and entitled,  
"TELSTAR SUBDIVISION Being a Subdivision of a Portion of Lot  
26 La Mesa Colony, in the City of San Diego, County of San  
Diego, State of California, according to map thereof No. 346,  
filed in the office of the County Recorder of said San Diego  
County March 8, 1887, together with the Northwestern half  
of that certain public highway which joins on the Southeasterly  
side of said portion of Lot 26, La Mesa Colony as per Map  
filed in the Recorder's Office and which highway is known as  
"Reservoir Drive" said highway is closed and vacated as such.",  
is made in the manner and form prescribed by law and conforms  
to the surrounding surveys; that said map and the subdivision  
of land shown thereon is hereby approved and accepted; and  
said Council hereby accepts on behalf of the public, the  
portions of public streets, to wit: a portion of Catoctin  
Drive and a portion of Curry Drive, for public purposes, and  
said portions of streets are hereby declared to be portions  
of public streets and dedicated to the public use.

The Clerk of said City is hereby authorized and directed  
to endorse upon said map, as and for the act of the Council,  
that said Council has approved said subdivision map and that  
said portions of streets are accepted on behalf of the public  
as heretofore stated.

Said City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit said map  
to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of  
San Diego, California.
