

ORDINANCE NO. **10273**
(New Series)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 26.22,
ARTICLE 6, CHAPTER II, OF THE SAN DIEGO
MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO THE INTER-
NATIONAL AFFAIRS BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Section 26.22, Article 6, Chapter II,
of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby
amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 26.22 INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS BOARD

(a) There is hereby created an International
Affairs Board which shall consist of fifteen (15)
members who shall serve without compensation. The
members shall be appointed by the Mayor and con-
firmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2)
year terms and each member shall serve until his
successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members
shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms
of not more than eight (8) members shall expire in
any year. The expiration date shall be March 1.
During March of each year, the Mayor may designate
one (1) member as Chairman; however, in the absence
of such designation, the Board shall, on or after
April 15, select from among their members a Chairman.

(b) All members shall be electors of the County
of San Diego at the time of appointment and during
incumbency and shall be qualified by training,
experience or interest in international affairs.

(c) Eight members shall constitute a
quorum and a majority vote but no less than five

affirmative votes shall be necessary to make any Board decision. The Board shall adopt its own rules of procedure.

(d) All officers, the City Manager, and independent department heads of the City shall cooperate with the Board and render all reasonable assistance to it.

(e) The Board shall render an annual report of its work to the Mayor."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SEC. 26.22 INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS BOARD

(a) There is hereby created an International Affairs Board ~~composed of fifteen members appointed by and at the pleasure of the Mayor and confirmed by Council~~ which shall consist of fifteen (15) members who shall serve without compensation. ~~Appointment shall be for a two-year term, but no longer than the elective term of the appointing Mayor.~~ ~~Each member shall serve until his successor is duly appointed and qualified.~~ ~~Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council.~~ ~~Members shall serve without compensation.~~ The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year terms and each member shall serve until his successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms of not more than eight (8) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date shall be March 1. During March of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairman; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall, on or after April 15, select from among their members a Chairman.

(c) ~~The Board shall select a Chairman from its membership annually.~~ Eight members shall constitute a quorum and a majority vote but no less than five affirmative votes shall be necessary to make any Board decision. The Board shall adopt its own rules of procedure.
