AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 26.01, ARTICLE 6, CHAPTER II, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO BOARD OF LIBRARY COMMISSIONERS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 26.01, Article 6, Chapter II, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 26.01 BOARD OF LIBRARY COMMISSIONERS

- (a) Purpose and Intent. It is the purpose and intent of the City Council in establishing the Board of Library Commissioners to provide the City's library system with the benefit of the advice of interested citizens representative of the community and to continue in existence without interruption the functions heretofore performed by the Library Commission, as previously established under the provisions of repealed Section 63 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
- Board of Library Commissioners which shall consist of seven (7) members, who shall serve without compensation. The commissioners shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year terms and each member shall serve until his successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms of not more than four (4) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date of all terms shall be

- March 1. During March of each year the Mayor may designate one (1) member as chairman; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall, on or after April 15, select from among their members a Chairman.
