

ORDINANCE NO. 10275
(New Series)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 26.30,
ARTICLE 6, CHAPTER II, OF THE SAN DIEGO
MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO THE PARK
AND RECREATION BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Section 26.30, Article 6, Chapter II,
of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby
amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 26.30 PARK AND RECREATION BOARD

(a) It is the purpose and intent of the City
Council to establish a policy advisory board on
matters relating to the acquisition, development,
maintenance and operation of parks, beaches and
recreation property and facilities and that the
Board will, along with other duties, perform the
functions of the former Park and Recreation Com-
mission and the former Mission Bay Commission.

(b) There is hereby created a Park and
Recreation Board consisting of eleven (11) members
who shall serve without compensation. The members
shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by
the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year
terms and each member shall serve until his successor
is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall
be appointed in such a manner that the terms of not
more than six (6) members shall expire in any year.
The expiration date shall be March 1. During March
of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member
as Chairman; however, in the absence of such designa-
tion, the Board shall, on or after April 15, select


from among their members a Chairman. The Park and Recreation Director shall serve as Secretary to the Board.

(c) The Board may adopt such rules, regulations and organizational structure for the conduct of its business as it may deem necessary.

(d) The Chairman, with the advice of the Board, shall appoint standing and ad hoc committees concerned with specific problems or areas of interest to the Board. Standing committees shall include, but not be limited to, committees on Mission Bay and Balboa Park. The committees shall be composed of Board members, augmented by other representative citizens appointed by the Board Chairman. The Board Chairman shall appoint board members as Chairman and Vice-Chairman of each such committee."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

(Paragraphs (a), (c) and (d) remain the same)

(b) There is hereby created a Park and Recreation Board consisting of eleven (11) members ~~appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council~~ who shall serve without compensation. Members shall be broadly representative of the community and shall serve without compensation. The members shall serve for a term of two (2) years but not longer than the elective term of the appointing Mayor and each member shall serve until his successor is duly appointed and qualified. The Mayor shall annually designate one member as Chairman. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year terms and each member shall serve until his successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms of not more than six (6) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date shall be March 1. During March of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairman; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall, on or after April 15, select from among their members a Chairman. The Park and Recreation Director shall serve as Secretary to the Board.

(b) There is hereby created a
Park and Recreation Board consist-
ing of eleven (11) members who
shall serve without compensation.
The members shall be appointed by
the Mayor and confirmed by the
Council. The members shall serve
two (2) year terms and each mem-
ber shall serve until his successor
is duly appointed and qualified. The
members shall be appointed in such
a manner that the terms of not more
than six (6) members shall expire
in any year. The expiration date
shall be March 1. During March of
each year, the Mayor may designate
one (1) member as Chairman; how-
ever, in the absence of such designa-
tion, the Board shall, on or after
April 15, select from among their
members a Chairman. The Park and
Recreation Director shall serve as
Secretary to the Board.

(c) The Board may adopt such
rules, regulations and organizational
structure for the conduct of its busi-
ness as it may deem necessary.

(d) The Chairman, with the advice
of the Board, shall appoint standing
and ad hoc committees concerned
with specific problems or areas of
interest to the Board. Standing com-
mittees shall include, but not be
limited to, committees on Mission
Bay and Balboa Park. The commit-
tees shall be composed of Board
members, augmented by other rep-
resentative citizens appointed by the
Board Chairman. The Board Chair-
man shall appoint board members
as Chairman and Vice-Chairman of
each such committee."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take
effect and be in force on the thirtieth
day from and after its passage.
