

ORDINANCE NO. **10276**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 101.0502,
ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER X, OF THE SAN DIEGO
MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO THE BOARD OF
ZONING APPEALS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Section 101.0502, Article 1, Chapter X,
of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby
amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 101.0502 BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS

1. Creation of Membership. There is hereby
created a Board of Zoning Appeals which shall consist
of five members who shall serve without compensation.
The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and con-
firmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2)
year terms and each member shall serve until his
successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members
shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms of
not more than three (3) members shall expire in any
year. The expiration date shall be March 1. During
March of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1)
member as Chairman; however, in the absence of such
designation, the Board shall, on or after April 15,
select from among their members a Chairman.

2. Meetings. The Board shall meet regularly once
a month or oftener if necessary for the transaction of
business. It shall establish its own rules and pro-
cedures necessary or convenient for the conduct of its
business.

Three members of the Board of Zoning Appeals shall

constitute a quorum. The affirmative vote of not less

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

than three members shall be necessary for any action by the Board.

3. Powers and Duties. To hear and determine appeals from the rulings, decisions and determinations of the Zoning Administrator, granting or denying applications for conditional use permits or for variances from the zoning provisions of the Municipal Code or zoning ordinances."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SEC. 101.0502 BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS

1. Creation of Membership. There is hereby created a Board of Zoning Appeals which shall consist of five members who shall serve without compensation. ~~Appointment shall be made by the Mayor, with Council confirmation. The members shall serve for terms of two years, but no individual appointment shall be longer than the elective term of the appointing Mayor; however, each member shall continue in office until his successor is duly appointed and qualified. Appointments made to fill the unexpired term of any member shall be for the unexpired term. Members may be removed for cause by the Mayor, with Council confirmation.~~ The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year terms and each member shall serve until his successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms of not more than three (3) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date shall be March 1. During March of each year, the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairman; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall, on or after April 15, select from among their members a Chairman.

2. Meetings. The Board shall meet regularly once a month or oftener if necessary for the transaction of business. It shall ~~elect a Chairman and~~ establish its own rules and procedures necessary or convenient for the conduct of its business.

Three members of the Board of Zoning Appeals shall constitute a quorum. The affirmative vote of not less than three members shall be necessary for any action by the Board.
