ORDINANCE NO. 10278 (New Series)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, SECTION H-203, OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO HOUSING CODE, RELATING TO HOUSING ADVISORY AND APPEALS BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Section H-203, of The City of San Diego Housing Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. H-203 HOUSING ADVISORY AND APPEALS BOARD

In order to provide for reasonable interpretation of the provisions of this Code there is hereby created a Housing Advisory and Appeals Board, consisting of five (5) members who shall be qualified by experience and training to pass upon matters pertaining to housing and who shall serve without compensation. The Building Official shall be an ex officio member and shall act as secretary of the Board. The members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The members shall serve two (2) year terms and each member shall serve until his successor is duly appointed and qualified. The members shall be appointed in such a manner that the terms of not more than three (3) members shall expire in any year. The expiration date of all terms shall be March 1. During March of each year the Mayor may designate one (1) member as Chairman; however, in the absence of such designation, the Board shall, on or after April 15, select from among their members a Chairman. The Board shall

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
