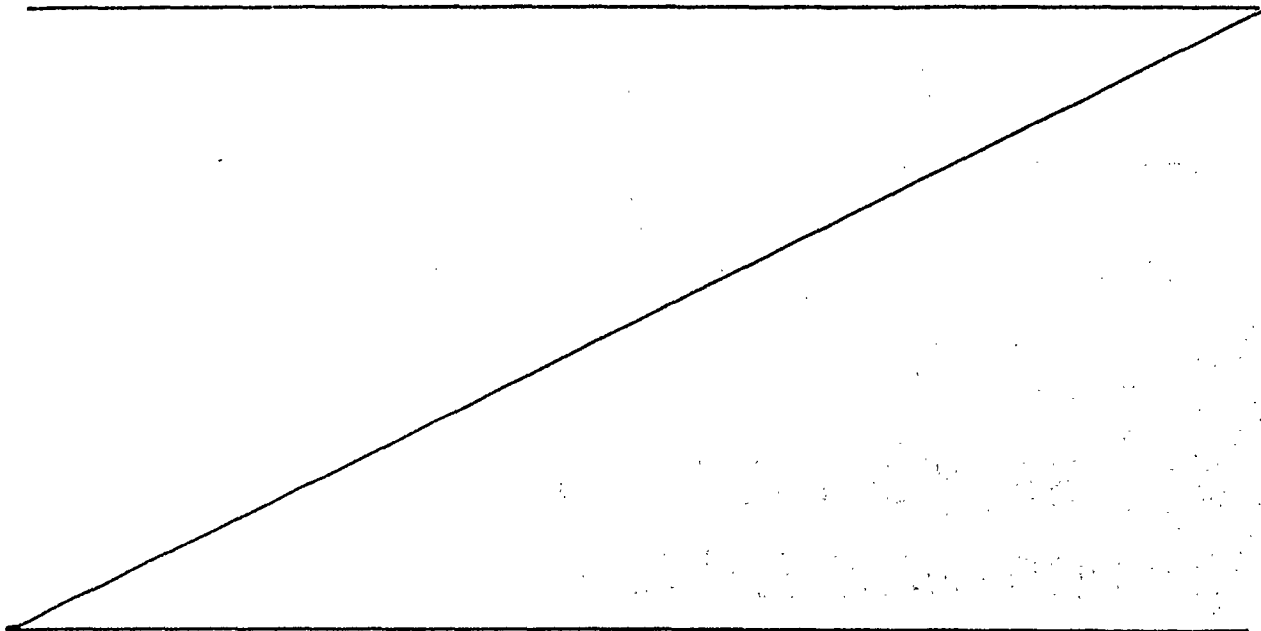
AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO OF CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS "NORTH MIRAMAR ANNEXATION."

WHEREAS, a petition has heretofore been filed with the Council of The City of San Diego for the annexation to said City of certain uninhabited territory designated as NORTH MIRAMAR ANNEXATION pursuant to the provisions of the Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939; and

WHEREAS, all of the provisions of said Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939, as amended, have been complied with; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council of The City of San Diego hereby approves the annexation to The City of San Diego of that certain territory in the County of San Diego, State of California, designated as NORTH MIRAMAR ANNEXATION and more particularly described as follows:



NORTH MIRAMAR ANNEXATION

All that unincorporated territory in the County of San Diego, State of California, being portions of Sections 21, 22 and Fractional Section 16, Township 14 South, Range 2 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, according to the Government Survey thereof, lying within the following described boundaries:

Beginning at an angle point in the boundary of the City of San Diego, established by Ordinance Number 8577 (New Series), adopted January 4, 1962, by the Council of the City of San Diego, being also corner Number Five, Rancho de los Penasquitos according to plat thereof in Book 2, Page 391 of Patents on file in the San Diego County Recorder's Office, and the most northerly corner of said Fractional Section 16;

1. Thence leaving said City boundary established by Ordinance Number 8577 (New Series) and proceeding southerly along the easterly line of said Fractional Section 16 to the corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21, and 22, Township 14 South, Range 2 West;

2. Thence easterly along the northerly line of said Section 22 to the easterly line of the north half of the northwest quarter of said Section 22;

3. Thence southerly along said easterly line of the north half of the northwest quarter of Section 22 to the northerly line of

southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section 22;

4. Thence easterly along said northerly line of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 22 to the easterly line of said southwest quarter of the northeast quarter Section 22;

5. Thence southerly along said easterly line of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 22 to the northerly line of the southeast quarter of said Section 22;

6. Thence easterly along said northerly line of the southeast quarter of Section 22 to the easterly line of said Section 22;

7. Thence southerly along said easterly line of Section 22 to the easterly line of a road and slope easement recorded as File Page 81881 and 81882, Series 1, Book 1960, in said County Recorder's Office;

8. Thence southerly along said easterly line of said road and slope easement the following courses:

- a. South  $32^{\circ} 24' 32''$  west, 120.51 feet;
- b. South  $19^{\circ} 59' 06''$  west, 149.48 feet;
- c. South  $09^{\circ} 35' 00''$  west, 220.39 feet to the southerly line of said Section 22;

9. Thence westerly along said southerly line of Section 22 to the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of said Section 22, being also an angle point in the boundary of the City of San Diego established by Resolution Number 195510,

10. Thence westerly, northerly and again westerly along said City boundary established by Resolution Number 195510, to an intersection with said City boundary established by Ordinance Number 8577 (New Series);

11. Thence northerly and northeasterly along said City boundary established by Ordinance Number 8577 (New Series) to the point of beginning.



Beginning at an angle point in the boundary of the City of San Diego, established by Ordinance Number 8577 (New Series), adopted January 4, 1963, by the Council of the City of San Diego, being also corner Number Five, Rancho de las Penasquitas according to plat thereof in Book 2, Page 291 of Patents on file in the San Diego County Recorder's Office, and the most northerly corner of said Fractional Section 18;

1. Thence leaving said City boundary established by Ordinance Number 8577 (New Series) and proceeding southerly along the easterly line of said Fractional Section 18 to the corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21, and 22, Township 14 South, Range 2 West;

2. Thence easterly along the northerly line of said Section 22 to the easterly line of the north half of the northwest quarter of said Section 22;

3. Thence southerly along said easterly line of the north half of the northwest quarter of Section 22 to the northerly line of southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of said Section 22;

4. Thence easterly along said northerly line of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 22 to the easterly line of said southwest quarter of the northeast quarter Section 22;

5. Thence southerly along said easterly line of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 22 to the northerly line of the southeast quarter of said Section 22;

6. Thence southerly along said northerly line of the southeast quarter of Section 22 to the easterly line of said Section 22;

7. Thence southerly along said easterly line of Section 22 to the easterly line of a road and slope easement recorded as File Page 8181 and 8182, Series 1, Book 1999, in said County Recorder's Office;

8. Thence southerly along said easterly line of said road and slope easement the following course:

a. South 22° 24' 25" West, 129.51 feet;

b. South 19° 59' 00" West, 169.45 feet;

c. South 69° 25' 00" West, 239.39 feet to the southerly line of said Section 22;

9. Thence westerly along said southerly line of Section 22 to the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of said Section 22, being also an angle point in the boundary of the City of San Diego established by Resolution Number 19819, adopted December 12, 1960, by the Council of the City of San Diego;

10. Thence westerly, northerly and again westerly along said City boundary established by Resolution Number 19819 to an intersection with said City boundary established by Ordinance Number 8577 (New Series);

11. Thence northerly and north-easterly along said City boundary established by Ordinance Number 8577 (New Series) to the point of beginning.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
