AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX RATE AND
LEVYING TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1970-71.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 75 of the Charter of The City of San Diego, there is hereby fixed a rate of taxation of One Dollar Ninety-Five Cents and Nine Mills (\$1.959) on each one hundred dollars' valuation of the taxable property within the City of San Diego, as shown on the assessment roll of the County of San Diego for the fiscal year 1970-71 and that rate is hereby levied on all taxable property, both real and personal, in the City of San Diego. Included herein is the amount required to be levied by Section 77a of said Charter.

Section 2. An allowance of three percent (3%) for anticipated delinquencies in tax payments upon real property and improvements thereon and personal property secured, other than properties of public utilities, is hereby established.

Section 3. This rate is computed as follows:

Section 4. The taxes hereby levied shall be due and payable and shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as State and County taxes in the County of San Diego.
