AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 31.0342A RELATING TO LICENSE TAX--PHOTOGRAPHIC MACHINE OPERATED BY COIN, DISC OR SLUG.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by amending Section 31.0342A to read as follows:

SEC. 31.0342A LICENSE TAX--PHOTOGRAPHIC MACHINE OPERATED BY COIN, DISC OR SLUG.

Every person engaged in the business of operating or maintaining any photographic machine operated by the deposit of a coin, disc, or slug shall pay a license tax of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) per month for each such machine, payable semiannually.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
