AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III,
ARTICLE 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL
CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 31.0367
RELATING TO LICENSE TAX--BARBER SHOPS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of The City of
San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 1 of the
San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended
by amending Section 31.0367 to read as follows:

SEC. 31.0367 LICENSE TAX--BARBER SHOPS

Every person conducting, managing or operating
any barber shop shall pay annually a license tax of
Twenty-five Dollars (\$25) per year plus Two Dollars
(\$2) per year per employee for the average number
employed during the preceding six (6) months.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and
be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its
passage.

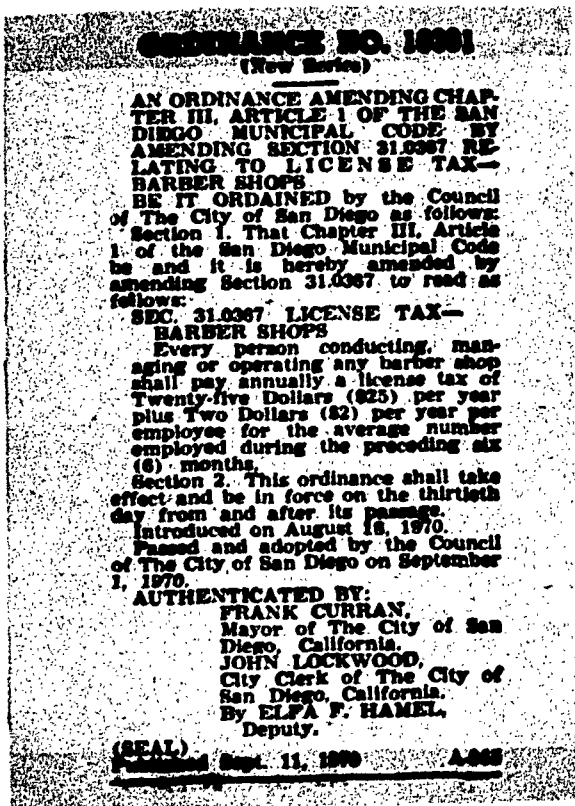
