Eligibles shall be certified in strict order of standing on the eligible list except in the following cases:

- (1) Whenever an eligible has indicated that he would not accept an appointment under the conditions applying to the position to be filled, his name may be passed over in the certification process.
- (2) Certification may be limited to a specified sex upon recommendation of the appointing authority and the approval of the Personnel Director.
- (3) Upon recommendation of the appointing authority and the approval of the City Manager and the Civil Service Commission, certification may be limited to persons who have passed a qualifying test to determine their ability to speak or read and write Spanish.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
