Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 4 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 34.01 to read as follows:

SEC. 34.01 BICYCLE LICENSE REQUIRED

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or use a bicycle propelled wholly or in part by human power upon any of the streets, alleys, or public highways of the City of San Diego, without first obtaining a license therefor.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Such license tabs shall remain attached to the bicycle during the term for which the license is issued. The Chief of Police shall keep a record of the date of issue of each license, to whom issued, and the number thereof.
