AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III,  
ARTICLE 4 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL  
CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 34.02  
RELATING TO BICYCLE LICENSES AND  
APPLICATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of The City of  
San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 4 of the  
San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby  
amended by amending Section 34.02 to read as follows:

SEC. 34.02 BICYCLE LICENSE AND APPLICATION

Upon written application to the San Diego  
Fire Department or to any department designated  
by the City Manager, a bicycle license will be  
issued which shall be effective for a period of  
five (5) years from the date of issuance during  
the period of time such licensee retains title  
to such bicycle. The license when issued shall  
entitle the licensee to operate such bicycle upon  
the streets, alleys and public highways in the City  
of San Diego in accordance with traffic regulations  
therefor.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be  
in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
