AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IX, ARTICLE 5, DIVISION 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF OUTDOOR ADVERTISING DISPLAYS BY ADDING SECTION 95.0326.

WHEREAS, it is the purpose and intent of the City Council in enacting this ordinance to extend the regulatory provisions of Chapter IX, Article 5, Division 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code, pertaining to the regulation of outdoor advertising displays, to all of Interstate 805 from its northerly terminus with Interstate 5 in Sorrento Canyon to its southern terminus in San Ysidro; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter IX, Article 5, Division 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same is hereby amended by adding Section 95.0326 to read as follows:

SEC. 95.0326 INTERSTATE 805 - REGULATED

Ysidro is within the regulatory provisions of this
division.


