### SEC. 21.04 HOLIDAYS

Except where otherwise specifically defined and provided in this Code, the holidays in The City of San Diego are:

- (a) January 1st;
- (b) February-22nd; Third Monday in February, known as "Washington's Birthday";
- (c) May-30th; Last Monday in May, known as "Memorial Day";
- (d) July 4th;
- (e) First Monday in September;
- (f) October-12th; Second Monday in October, known as "Columbus Day";
- (g) November-11th; Fourth Monday in October, known as "Veterans' Day";
- (h) December 25th; and
- (i) Every day appointed by the President, Governor, or the City Council for a public fast, thanksgiving or holiday.

If January 1st, February-22nd, May-30th, July 4th, October-12th, November-11th, or December 25th fall upon a Sunday, the Monday following is a holiday.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 1 of the San Diego  
Municipal Code be amended by amending Section 21.04 to read  
as follows:

SEC. 21.04 HOLIDAYS

Except where otherwise specifically defined and  
provided in this Code, the holidays in The City of San  
Diego are:

- (a) January 1st;
- (b) Third Monday in February, known as "Washington's  
Birthday";
- (c) Last Monday in May, known as "Memorial Day";
- (d) July 4th;
- (e) First Monday in September;
- (f) Second Monday in October, known as "Columbus  
Day";
- (g) Fourth Monday in October, known as "Veterans'  
Day";

(h) December 25th; and

(i) Every day appointed by the President, Governor, or the City Council for a public fast, thanksgiving or holiday.

If January 1st, July 4th or December 25th fall upon a Sunday, the Monday following is a holiday.


