The Purchasing Agent is hereby directed to post conspicuously for five (5) days, on or near the Council Chamber door in the manner and form required by law, the notice, together with a copy of the prevailing wage schedule established by Resolution No. 193707, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing the work ordered; and the Purchasing Agent is hereby directed to publish twice in the City Official Newspaper a notice inviting such proposals for doing the work.
