
Res. Ordering Vacation--easements required -- 2

Reserving and excepting to The City of San Diego the right, easement and privilege of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to sewer, water, drainage, gas, electric and telephone facilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along and across the hereinafter described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom, together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or trees thereon, or the drilling or digging of any well or wells thereon, together with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved. Upon written permission of the City or any grantee from the City of the right to utilize the said easement herein, the owners of the underlying fee may utilize the above described parcel of land for structures, the planting or growing of trees or the installation of privately owned The City of San Diego shall have the right to permit the use of the easement or easements herein described by any public utility either by conveyance of the necessary right to so use or by permitting such utility to utilize such right under and pursuant to a franchise with The City of San Diego.

The easement reserved herein is in, under, over, upon, along and across the following described property:

The Northerly 15 feet of the EAST-WEST ALLEY, BLOCK 193, PACIFIC BEACH.
