RESOLUTION NO. 199118

WHEREAS, PENASQUITOS, INC., an Illinois corporation,
Owner, "Permittee," filed an application for a conditional use
permit to construct and operate a 400-space Mobile Home Park,
consisting of approximately 132 acres, located west of Genesee
Avenue south of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad rightof-way, east of Interstate 5 and north of University City Subdivisions and within an area called Rose Canyon, being a portion
of Pueblo Lots 1252, 1267, 1268, 1269, 1291, 1292, 1293,
1294 and Unnumbered Pueblo Lots, more particularly described in
Appendix A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, in the M-2
and R-1-5 (proposed R-2) Zones; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 1969, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego made its findings of facts, which are set forth in Resolution No. 217-PC, and granted a conditional use permit to Permittee to construct and operate said 400-space Mobile Home Park; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on January 8, 1970, continued to February 19, 1970, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted and the Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That all of the following facts exist with respect to the denial of said conditional use permit on the property described in the preamble of this resolution:

1. The proposed use at the particular location is not necessary to provide a facility which will contribute to the general well-being of the community.

- 2. Such use will, under the circumstances of the particular case, be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of persons residing or working in the vicinity, or injurious to property or improvements in the vicinity.
- The proposed use will not comply with the regulations and conditions specified in the Code for such use.
- 4. The granting of this conditional use will adversely affect the General Plan of the City or the adopted plan of any governmental agency.

The above findings are further supported by the minutes, tape of the proceedings, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that by a vote of 7 to 1, the decision of the Planning Commission granting a conditional use permit to PENASQUITOS, INC. be, and the same is overruled; and the appeal of UNIVERSITY CITY CIVIC ASSOCIATION by Edward T. Butler, Attorney be, and it is hereby granted.
