WHEREAS, the school tax override approved by voters in 1964 is due to expire on June 30, 1970; and

WHEREAS, many school activities such as summer school, extra-curricular activities by teachers, and counseling services will be curtailed if this tax override expires; and

WHEREAS, a critical need exists for continued financing at present levels for school activities from elementary school through high school; and

WHEREAS, in the special election to be conducted on March 3, 1970, Proposition A provides for retention of the \$3.60 tax rate for the San Diego Unified School District and thereby continues the tax override previously approved by the voters; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the City Council of The City of San Diego hereby supports passage of Proposition A and urges all citizens to vote "Yes" on said Proposition.
