

# RESOLUTION No. 199179

Adopted on MAR 3 1970

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the bid of \$272,980.35 by GRIFFITH COMPANY, A Corporation, for THE IMPROVEMENT OF HANCOCK STREET, KURTZ STREET AND CHANNEL WAY ADJACENT TO SPORTS ARENA BOULEVARD AND STATE ROUTE 109 in the City of San Diego, California, is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract therefor in accordance with the Specifications on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 730477.
  
2. That the expenditure of \$157,000.00 is hereby authorized out of the Gas Tax Fund (219) and that the expenditure of \$171,000.00 is hereby authorized out of the Capital Outlay Fund (245) of the City of San Diego solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the IMPROVEMENT OF HANCOCK STREET, KURTZ STREET AND CHANNEL WAY ADJACENT TO SPORTS ARENA BOULEVARD AND STATE ROUTE 109 in the City of San Diego, and related costs.
  
3. Accepting the contribution of \$1,000.00 each from Queen Anne Corporation and Mr. Lyle W. Butler for property owner's share of that portion of street improvements in Hancock Street abutting P. L. 276.
