RESOLUTION NO. 199251

A RESOLUTION URGING SUPPORT OF PROPOSITION 7 AT THE JUNE 2ND CALIFORNIA ELECTION

WHEREAS, the State of California has a substantial number of unsold bonds which were authorized to complete construction of the State Water Project, to finance veterans, farm and home loans, the State's portion of school construction, and for many other purposes; and

WHEREAS, as the result of circumstances beyond the control of the State, these bonds are unsold due to certain constitutional limitations on interest payments which cause said bonds to be noncompetitive in today's market for such securities; and

WHEREAS, to correct this unfortunate situation, the Legislature has proposed a constitutional amendment to be known as Proposition 7 at the statewide election of June 2, 1970, which will increase the maximum State interest rate on such securities to 7% per annum and allow the State Legislature to increase maximum interest rates if future circumstances warrant, thereby permitting the sale of these securities under competitive bidding procedures; and

WHEREAS, while neither of these measures may be needed if interest rates subsequently are lowered, in the interim, the State must be able to meet its obligations and those it owes to its citizens; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Council of San Diego supports the adoption of Proposition 7 at the State Election of June 2, 1970, and urges all voters of the State to support said proposition.
