SUBDIVISION REVIEW BOARD RESOLUTION NO. R-74

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Subdivision Review Board of the City of San Diego:

That tentative map, VISTA DE MIGUEL UNIT NO. 4 & 5, a two-unit, 98-lot (more or less) subdivision of portion of Quarter Section 26, Rancho de la Nacion, located between Paradise Valley Road and Skyline Drive, easterly of Meadowbrook Drive, in the R-1-5 zone, be, and it is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1 The General Conditions of Approval for Tentative Maps filed in the Office of the City Clerk under Document 697179 shall be made a condition of map approval;
- 2 Parkbrook St. between Glen Vista Street and Parkbrook Way shall be dedicated and improved as a 60 foot collector street with 40 feet of pavement, curb and sidewalk;
- 3 Glen Vista Street within the subject subdivision shall be dedicated and improved as a 60 foot collector street with 40 feet of pavement, curb and sidewalk.
- 4 Glen Vista Street, along the southerly termination of the subject subdivision, shall be provided with temporary offsite cul-de-sacs;
- 5 The new pavement schedule as specified in the City's Engineering Department Manual No. 1100-70 (Revised 7-6-67) shall be used to determine pavement thickness on all streets bounding or within the subject subdivision in lieu of the Schedule "B" or 3-inch over 6-inch type pavement as specified in the General Conditions for Tentative Maps under Document 697179;
- 6 A geological report shall be provided to substantiate the high-cut banks within the subject subdivision; and all slopes shall be designed for proper stability considering both the geological factors and soil properties;
- 7 Electrical and telephone service facilities shall be installed underground in accordance with Ordinance No. 11064-NS;
- 8 Subdivider shall pay a water area charge as required for the Paradise Mesa Area and per Resolutions 197625; and a sewer area charge per Resolutions 175570 and 197624;
- 9 Subdivider shall comply with the Conditions of the Planning Department contained in City Clerk's Document No. 717910.
