WHEREAS, the City of Coronado has announced an intention to annex that unincorporated area of the County of San Diego known as North Island; and

WHEREAS, North Island was originally part of the City of San Diego, is surrounded on three sides by the boundaries of the City of San Diego, and is served with sewer and water facilities by the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, North Island is the property of the Federal Government and the North Island Naval Air Station is located thereon; and

WHEREAS, most of the personnel working at said Naval
Air Station in fact live in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, Section 35471 of the Government Code of the State of California requires the consent of the Federal Government before federal property can be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the Council should take a position disapproving the attempt of the City of Coronado to annex North Island; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City of San Diego disapproves the annexation of North Island by the City of Coronado.
- 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary steps to ascertain the view of the U. S. Navy on the future status of North Island as unincorporated territory and explore the possibility of its ultimate annexation to the City of San Diego.
