

RESOLUTION NO. 199372

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation has recently announced its initiation of an Urban Corridor Demonstration Program; and

WHEREAS, this program is to test and demonstrate the concerted use of available transportation technology and hardware in solving critical commuting hour (or hours) congestion problems with particular attention to traffic corridors leading to the central business districts; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego qualifies for the funding of a demonstration project under this program; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego feels that the overall system's approach is essential to the ultimate solution of corridor traffic congestion; and

WHEREAS, the corridor connecting El Cajon Valley and the central business district of the City of San Diego is experiencing peak-hour congestion, and this congestion will intensify over the next few years; and

WHEREAS, technology and tools are currently available for the solution of these congestion problems; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego desires to design, test and develop an automated guideway system to solve these problems; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that \$2,000,000 will be required to complete the study; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of The City of San Diego endorses and supports a first phase application for \$200,000 to the Department of Transportation for an Urban Corridor

Demonstration Program Grant and hereby authorizes the City Manager to file said application with the Department of Transportation and do such things as necessary to process said application.
