RESOLUTION NO. 199399

WHEREAS, the Master Plan of San Diego State College, as revised in 1967, provides for a maximum of 20,000 full-time equivalent students in day classes; and

WHEREAS, it is expected that requests for enrollment will greatly exceed 20,000 full-time equivalent students prior to 1976, which is the earliest date the Board of Trustees of the California State Colleges have agreed to provide an additional campus for San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, enrollment in excess of 20,000 will produce intolerable traffic and parking problems in the San Diego State College area to the detriment of persons working and living in the area and to property values in the area; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

This Council strongly urges the Board of Trustees of the California State Colleges to provide for an additional campus in San Diego County at the earliest possible time so that enrollment at San Diego State College will at no time exceed 20,000 full-time equivalent students in day classes.
