

RESOLUTION NO. 199433

WHEREAS, in establishing the City of San Diego Human Resources Committee it is the purpose and intent of the Council to provide a small group which can effectively analyze, study, evaluate and make appropriate recommendations to the Council with respect to policy positions on human resources programs; and

WHEREAS, the Council further intends to provide for the coordination of City efforts in human resources to the end that maximum results are obtained from all programs; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for full communication of information between the Mayor, the Council and all City-related agencies involved in human resources programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Council that this Committee be created for the purpose of advising the Council with regard to technical questions raised by human resources programs; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That there is hereby created the Committee on Human Resources composed of five members who shall be the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor, the two Councilmen elected by the Council to serve on the Model Cities Liaison Committee and the City Manager or his representative. The Committee shall regularly invite the following to all scheduled meetings: (a) the Personnel Director of The City of San Diego or his representative, (b) the Director of the Economic Opportunities Commission or his representative, (c) the Chief Staff Directors of the Mayor's Committee on Jobs, Inc. or their

representatives, (d) representatives of the San Diego Unified School District, (e) representatives of the State Human Resources Agency, and (f) such others as the Committee deems appropriate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Committee shall have the responsibility for providing policy interpretation and coordination for all human resources programs operated by or under contract to The City of San Diego. The Committee shall advise the Council concerning policy in the area of human resources and shall recommend a human resources program for Council approval. The Committee shall also solicit information regarding human resources programs in the City of San Diego and shall render such reports to the Council as may be required to keep the Council informed on matters pertaining to human resources.
