

RESOLUTION No. 200073

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the bid of \$56,000.00 by DBX, Inc. dba Perry Electric, A Corporation, for the CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND SAFETY LIGHTING SYSTEMS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF 4TH AVENUE AND CEDAR STREET, 6TH AVENUE AND PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE; AND ADRIAN STREET, RUE D'ORLEANS AND WEST POINT LOMA BOULEVARD in the City of San Diego, California, is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract therefor in accordance with the form on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 731822.

2. That the expenditure of \$66,000.00 is hereby authorized out of the Gas Tax Fund (219) of the City of San Diego solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND SAFETY LIGHTING SYSTEMS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF 4TH AVENUE AND CEDAR STREET, 6TH AVENUE AND PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE; AND ADRIAN STREET, RUE D'ORLEANS AND WEST POINT LOMA BOULEVARD in the City of San Diego, and related costs.



