WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of this City

Council that a proposal to establish a County Transportation

Agency is to be considered by the Board of Supervisors of

the County of San Diego in the near future; and

WHEREAS, based on information available to this City Council, it would appear that said Transportation Agency may have significant responsibility for transportation problems connected with the citizens of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has more than 50% of the population and the assessed valuation for the entire County, and contributes proportionately, financially and otherwise, to the Comprehensive Planning Organization; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Planning Organization of the County of San Diego has for some time engaged in studies relating to transportation problems concerning the citizens of the City of San Diego and the County of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego strongly supports this agency which is directed by the elected officials of the County; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has a deep and abiding interest in transportation problems, surface and otherwise, relating to not only its citizens but citizens of the surburban areas to which this City now provides certain transportation services by virtue of its participation in the San Diego Transit Corporation activities; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has a continuing interest in not only providing this service but in representing or joining with other public agencies in the improvement of transportation services; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That this City Council requests that the Board of Supervisors, prior to forming such Transportation Agency as more fully set forth above, meet and confer with elected officials of this City and other cities within the County to discuss the form and function of the proposed agency to the end that should said agency be formed, it will be able to function with the support of all other governmental agencies concerned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk be, and he is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
