That Change Order No. 2, dated July 6, 1970, heretofore filed with the City Clerk of said City as Document No.

732776 issued in connection with the contract between The City of San Diego and T. B. PENICK & SONS, INC. for the improvement of MISSION HILLS PARK, said contract having been filed as Document No. 731114 in the office of the City Clerk be, and the same is hereby approved; and the changes therein set forth, amounting to an increase in the contract price of \$10,237.21 be, and the same are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of \$10,237.21 is hereby authorized out of Park and Recreation Bond Fund 725 of The City of San Diego solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the improvement of MISSION HILLS PARK, supplementing Resolution No. 199061 in this amount.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the request contained in said Change Order No. 2 for an extension of time of 85 days, to wit, to and including August 26, 1970, in which to complete said contract be, and the same is hereby approved, and the time of completion under said contract is hereby extended to August 26, 1970.
