WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is the owner of portions of Lots 43 through 47, and all of Lot 48, Block 290, Seaman and Choate's Addition, according to Map thereof No. 223, filed September 10, 1886, in the office of the San Diego County Recorder; and

WHEREAS, the real property hereinafter more particularly described is surplus to all City needs; and

WHEREAS, the real property contains approximately 12,012 square feet; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, pursuant to Section 22.0902.1 of the San Diego Municipal Code recommends that the said property hereinafter more particularly described be sold at public auction; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 7. That the seller's expenses in connection with the sale of said property, including the aforementioned real estate broker's commission shall be deducted from the proceeds received from said sale.
