BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the bid received from San Diego Gas & Electric Company on August 6, 1970 for a franchise to construct, maintain and use poles, wires, conduits and appurtenances for transmitting and distributing electricity for heating and power purposes in the streets of the City of San Diego on conditions expressed in a letter dated August 6, 1970 from J. F. Sinnott, President of San Diego Gas & Electric Company, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 732984, be, and the same is declared to be nonresponsive and therefore rejected; and

### City of San Diego Electric Franchise

San Diego Gas & Electric Company hereby submits its bid in the amount of \$50,000 for a franchise to construct, maintain and use poles, wires, conduits and appurtenances for transmitting and distributing electricity for heating and power purposes in the streets of the City of San Diego in the form set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to City Council Resolution No. 200376, subject to the condition that the following provisions of the proposed franchise ordinance be amended to read as follows:

## Section 1. DEFINITIONS, Subsection (g):

"(g) The phrase "gross receipts" shall mean all receipts derived by Grantee from the sale of electricity to Grantee's consumers within the corporate limits of the City irrespective of the use to which said electricity is put by Grantee's customers but excluding interdepartmental sales by Grantee and excluding refunds or rebates to customers by Grantee as ordered by the California Public Utilities Commission."

#### 2. TERM: Section 3.

"Section 3. TERM

"The right, privilege and franchise, subject to each and all of the terms and conditions contained in this ordinance hereby is granted to a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of California, for an indeterminate term from and after the effective date hereof."



3. Section 4. CONSIDERATION:

"Section 4. CONSIDERATION

"The rights and privileges herein granted are upon the express condition that Grantee, as consideration therefor and as compensation for the use of the streets of the City as herein authorized and permitted, shall pay annually to City in lawful money of the United States, a sum equal to two per cent (2%) of Grantee's gross receipts during the preceding calendar year, or fractional year, arising from the use, operation or possession of said franchise; provided, however, that such payment shall in no event be less than one-half per cent of Grantee's gross receipts as defined herein."

For the first ten years of the franchise, San Diego Gas & Electric Company would further agree that in no event shall the total amount paid in any year be less than the franchise payment made to the City by it for the year 1969.

- 4. Section 5. REPORTS, DATES OF PAYMENT TO CITY, AUDITS, Subsection (g):
- "(g) Grantee shall file with the City Clerk a duplicate of those portions which are germane to the franchise payments of the Grantee's annual financial report filed with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California or its successors in authority, as soon as practicable after the original of said report has been filed with the said Commission, or its successors in authority."
  - 5. Section 8. CITY RESERVED POWERS:

Entire section to be deleted.

6. Section 9. RELOCATION:

"Section 9. RELOCATION

"(a) Grantee shall relocate, without expense to City, any poles, wires, conduits and appurtenances installed, maintained or used in the streets under said franchise, if and when made necessary by any lawful change of grade, alignment or width of any streets by City, including the construction of any subway or viaduct; provided,

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however, that this ordinance shall not be applicable to the cost of any relocation made necessary by the construction of any lawful change of grade, alignment or width of any freeway constructed by the State of California.

"(b) Undergrounding. Grantee shall allocate such funds to City as it is from time to time directed by the California Public Utilities Commission for the purpose of undergrounding its overhead facilities, other than transmission lines, and shall proceed expeditiously under the direction of said Commission and in cooperation with City to apply those funds to the undergrounding of such facilities located within City."

7. Section 11. REPAIR COSTS:

"Section 11. REPAIR COSTS

"Grantee shall pay to City on demand the cost of all repairs to City property made necessary by any of the operations of Grantee under the franchise granted hereby; provided, however, that Grantee shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to make such repairs itself at its own cost."

8. Section 12. FORFEITURE:

Entire section to be deleted.

9. Section 19. PERFORMANCE BOND:

"Section 19. PERFORMANCE BOND

"Grantee shall file and maintain a faithful performance bond in favor of the City as beneficiary in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) conditioned that Grantee shall well and truly observe, fulfill and perform each and every term and condition of the franchise herein granted, and that in case of any breach of any condition of the bond, the amount of the penal sum made in the bond shall be recoverable from the principal and sureties upon said bond, which bond shall be acknowledged by Grantee as principal and by a corporation licensed by the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California to transact the business of a fidelity and surety insurance company as surety."
