A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION OR COMPLETION OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS AND MAKING FINDINGS RELATING THERETO.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. The public interest and necessity demand the acquisition, construction or completion of certain improvements, to wit: to construct, improve or otherwise provide in the City of San Diego, Old Town area, a historical, cultural, educational and recreational complex including buildings and related facilities necessary for operation of a complete facility for the collection, preservation and presentation of historical attractions, which would include but not be limited to, contributions of early western modes of travel, as well as fire apparatus, and railroad equipment used from the earliest settlement times to the present, and for purposes related and necessary to these objectives. The estimated cost of this municipal improvement is the sum of Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000).

Section 2. The cost of the foregoing municipal improvement and the principal amount of the bonded indebtedness proposed to be incurred shall and will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of the City and will require an expenditure greater than the amount provided by the annual tax levy.

Section 3. This municipal improvement is necessary and convenient to carry out the objects, purposes and powers of The City of San Diego.

Section 4. This Council intends to submit to the qualified voters of the City at a special municipal bond election to be held in the City on November 3, 1970, and to be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date, one (1) proposition for the issuance of general obligation bonds of the City, all of such bond issue being in the principal amount of the estimated cost of the municipal improvement, as set forth in this resolution.
