RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND SPECIAL MUNICIPAL BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 1970, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THAT SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, this Council intends to call a special municipal election and special municipal bond election to be held on November 3, 1970, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City two propositions as set forth in this resolution amending the Charter of The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, this Council has commenced proceedings and intends to call a special municipal election and special municipal bond election in the City to be held on November 3, 1970, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City two general obligation bond propositions as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this special municipal election and special municipal bond election be consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on the same date and that within the City the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and special municipal bond election, and that the statewide general election and this special municipal election and special municipal bond election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has or will adopt an ordinance calling for a special municipal election and special municipal bond election and consolidating it with the statewide general election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate a special municipal election and special municipal bond election to be held in the City of San Diego on November 3, 1970, with the statewide general election to be held on the same date.

2. The exact form of the propositions to be voted upon at the special municipal election and special municipal bond election as such propositions shall appear on the ballot is as follows:

<p>PROPOSITION <u>B</u>. CITY OF SAN DIEGO CHARTER AMENDMENTS. AMEND SECTIONS 12 AND 24 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.</p>	<p>YES</p>	
<p>Amend Sections 12 and 24 to provide that the Mayor and Councilmen shall not engage in any business or transaction or have a financial or other personal interest, direct or indirect, which is incompatible with the proper discharge of their duties or which would tend to impair their independence of judgment or action in the performance of such duties, and that the rate of pay for the Mayor shall be Fifteen Hundred Dollars per month, and the rate of pay for each additional Councilman shall be Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars per month.</p>	<p>NO</p>	

<p>PROPOSITION <u> D </u>. CITY OF SAN DIEGO CHARTER AMENDMENTS. AMEND SECTIONS 70 AND 130 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.</p> <p>Amend Section 70 to allow the City Council to revise salaries of City employees at any time during the fiscal year provided sufficient funds are available and budgeted by deleting certain restrictive language and unnecessary reference to specific officials; and amend Section 130 by deleting language making it mandatory that the Civil Service Commission furnish salary recommendations to the City Council prior to the adoption of the Annual Salary Ordinance.</p>	<p>YES</p>

CITY OF SAN DIEGO WILD ANIMAL PARK RECREATIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES BOND PROPOSAL: to improve, develop and expand the area of the San Pasqual Valley known as the San Diego Wild Animal Park, shall the City incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of Six Million Dollars</p>	<p>YES</p>	
<p>to permit the acquisition, construction and completion of facilities to provide recreational, educational, scientific, ecological and research facilities in harmony with the open space concept of the valley?</p>	<p>NO</p>	

PROPOSITION <u>C</u> . CITY OF SAN DIEGO HISTORICAL, CULTURAL, EDUCATIONAL AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES BOND PROPOSAL: to improve, develop and expand the historical, cultural, educational and recreational facilities of the City, shall the City incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of Four Million Dollars to construct, improve or otherwise provide in the City of San Diego, Old Town area, a historical, cultural, educational and recreational complex including buildings and related facilities necessary for operation of a complete facility for the collection, preservation, and presentation of historical attractions, which would include but not be limited to, contributions of early western modes of travel, as well as fire apparatus, and railroad equipment used from the earliest settlement times to the present? The propositions shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10231 of the California Elections Code.

3. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and special municipal bond election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.

4. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the statewide general election, instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.

5. The City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors, County Clerk and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
