

WHEREAS, the Federal Government has authorized and funded a "TOPICS" program which consists of making traffic operation improvements on a systematic basis in accordance with an area-wide plan over a network of arterial and other major streets within urban areas; and

WHEREAS, before Federal aid will be made available for a local TOPICS program, the local agency and the State of California are required to enter into an agreement with respect to the preparation of an area-wide TOPICS plan and with respect to the construction, maintenance and evaluation of such TOPICS improvement projects as may be financed in part with Federal TOPICS' funds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, a master agreement with the State of California entitled, "Traffic Operations Program to Increase Capacity and Safety" (TOPICS) under the terms and conditions set forth in the form of agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 733474.

2. The City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized and empowered, subject to the direction provided by the Progress Guide and General Plan for the City of San Diego including changes thereto as adopted by the City Council and by budget documents adopted by the City Council, to make all applications, studies and reports and to provide certifications and information as may be required to obtain for City the Federal-aid

funds available under the TOPICS program. Such actions include, but are not necessarily limited to the following:

a. Preparing and submitting the General Plan for Highway Improvements, the Area-wide TOPICS Plan and Study Report, the Federal-aid Primary Type II Street System and the list of traffic operation improvement priorities.


b. Providing assurances that the TOPICS Plan and the Type II Street System have been coordinated with contiguous jurisdictions where applicable and that the recommended plan of development has been coordinated with plans for local public or mass transportation services, with possible plans for fringe parking, and with airport access planning.

c. Providing assurance that whether or not Federal aid is granted for the purpose, the City intends to implement the plan of traffic operation improvements as it shall be submitted within a reasonable period to the extent that it can be done with available funds.

d. Certifying and providing any requested evidence prior to advertising a project for construction that necessary rights of way are available or will be available by the time of contract award.
