That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Barbara Thompson	WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT Customer Service Division	\$30	This suggestion led to a reduction in the cost of obtaining information requested by customers as to total charges for water and sewer service for the past year. This saves about \$300 a year.
James C. Price	FIRE DEPARTMENT	\$20	This Fire Engineer suggested, designed, and constructed a special rack to hold 10 55-gallon drums of oil at the Department Repair Facility. This saves considerable time in handling drums when the contents are needed. It also eliminates a dangerous condition that existed when drums had to be moved by muscle instead of a hoist.
Bruce C. Hopkins	PARKS & PUBLIC BUILDINGS Buildings & Facilities Div.	\$10	Suggested infra-red lamps to dry paint on barricade parts. This has been done to save \$57 per year net in the cost of making barricades.
Arthur Hoopes	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$10	Proposed use of gummed labels on cardboard citation boxes so they can be reused six times instead of once. Saves \$77 a year in the cost of the boxes.
Richard J. Jansen	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$10	Had bicycle licensing ordinance changed to provide for five instead of ten year effective period. This saves clerical time and handling time for records. In five years the annual saving will be about \$300. In the first year it will be about a fifth of this amount as the changeover begins.
Robert F. Radder	FIRE DEPARTMENT	\$10	Suggested signs for rear of fire apparatus warning traffic to stay 300 feet back. This should improve safety and make law enforcement easier.
Charles E. Kinnel	FIRE DEPARTMENT	\$15	Changed design of welding on hose bridges to stop them breaking. Saves \$165 a year for rewelding and provides greater safety.
