BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the public interest, convenience and necessity of said City requires the reservation of certain public easement(s), as more particularly referred to in Resolution of Intention No.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that portions of WINDER STREET and INDIA STREET, between and adjacent to Blocks 167 and 175 of Middletown,

as more particularly shown on Map No. 11920-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 733823 which said map is attached hereto marked Exhibit A and made a part hereof, be, and the same is hereby vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego reserves and excepts from the foregoing vacation the permanent easement(s) as more particularly shown on Map No. 11920-B, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 733823, and as more particularly described hereinafter:

Res, Ordering Vacation -- easements required -- 2

Reserving and excepting to The City of San Diego the right, easement and privilege of placing, constructing, repairing, replacing, maintaining, using and operating public utilities of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to sewer, water, drainage, gas, electric and telephone facilities and all necessary and proper fixtures and equipment for use in connection therewith, through, over, under, upon, along and across the hereinafter described easement, together with the right of ingress thereto and egress therefrom, together with the right to maintain the said easement free and clear of any excavation or fills, the erection or construction of any building or other structures, the planting of any tree or trees thereon, or the drilling or digging of any well or wells thereon, together with the right to otherwise protect from all hazards the operation and use of any right hereby reserved. Upon written permission of the City or any grantee from the City of the right to utilize the said easement herein, the owners of the underlying fee may utilize the above described parcel of land for structures, the planting or growing of trees or the installation of privately owned pipelines. The City of San Diego shall have the right to permit the use of the easement or easements herein described by any public utility either by conveyance of the necessary right to so use or by permitting such utility to utilize such right under and pursuant to a franchise with The City of San Diego.

The easement reserved herein is in, under, over, upon, along and across the following described property:

All that portion of INDIA STREET as vacated and WINDER STREET as vacated, as established according to the map of Middletown according to Partition Map thereof made by J. E. Jackson, on file in the office of the County Clerk of said San Diego County, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the most easterly corner of Lot 7, Block 175 of said Middletown, thence South 50° 11' 02" East, 6.21 feet to the beginning of a nontangent 70.00 foot radius curve concave northeasterly, a radial to said point bears South 54° 00' 22" West; thence along the arc of said curve through a central angle of 7° 22' 14"; a distance of 9.00 feet; thence leaving said curve South 54° 01' 09" West, 34.67 feet; thence North 60° 41' 24" West, 16.51 feet; thence North 54° 01' 09" East, 39.47 feet to the point of beginning.


