

RESOLUTION NO. 201546 DEC 29 1970

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has established priority lists for certain underground conversion projects commencing with the calendar year 1966, all as more particularly set forth in Resolutions numbered 194285, 197868 and 199402; and

WHEREAS, these resolutions covered the conversion of facilities to underground in the calendar years 1968 through 1970; and

WHEREAS, it would now appear that certain additional projects are feasible; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the Council hereby establishes the following priorities for major street and park-related underground conversion projects for the calendar years 1971 through 1976:

I. MAJOR STREET UNDERGROUND CONVERSION PROJECTS
FOR THE PERIOD 1971 THROUGH 1976

- A) Projects proposed for undergrounding within Calendar Year 1971.
 - 1. Harbor Drive, Pacific Highway to Rosecrans
 - 2. Pacific Highway, Harbor Drive to Laurel Street
 - 3. Palm Avenue, National Avenue to proposed Interstate Route 805
- B) Major street routes requiring a series of projects, the first of which would be scheduled for Calendar Year 1971. Specific project limits and their order to be determined based on further cost analysis, system needs and coordination with other City projects.
 - 1. College Avenue, La Mesa City Limits to Navajo Road

2. La Jolla Boulevard, Pearl Street, Torrey Pines Road and Ardath Road Route, Turquoise to Interstate 5
 3. West Point Loma Boulevard and Sunset Cliffs Route, Sports Arena Boulevard to Point Loma Boulevard
 4. University Avenue, Washington Street to East City Limits
- C) Major street routes requiring a series of projects, the first of which will be scheduled for Calendar Year 1972 or 1973. Specific project limits and their order to be determined based on further cost analysis, system needs and coordination with other City projects.
1. Clairemont Mesa Boulevard, Clairemont Drive to Interstate 805
 2. Euclid Avenue and 54th Street Route, Imperial Avenue to El Cajon Boulevard
 3. Garnet Avenue, Balboa Avenue Route, Mission Boulevard to Interstate 805
 4. Grand Avenue, Mission Boulevard to East Mission Bay Drive
 5. Imperial Avenue, Harbor Drive to East City Limits
 6. Linda Vista Road, Morena Boulevard to Tait Street
 7. Rosecrans Street, Taylor Street, Fort Rosecrans to Interstate 8
 8. Washington Street and El Cajon Boulevard Route, Pacific Highway to East City Limits

II. PARK-RELATED UNDERGROUND PROJECTS FOR THE PERIOD 1971 THROUGH 1976

- A) Park projects scheduled for completion in 1971 which have undergrounding requirements.
1. Highland-Landis Recreation Center (CIP 23-350)
 2. Kearny Mesa Park and Recreation Center (CIP 23-471)

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3. Knox Park (CIP 23-790)
 4. Point Loma Park and Recreation Center (CIP 23-550)
 5. Vista Terrace Park (CIP 23-326)
- B) Park projects scheduled for completion after 1971 which have undergrounding requirements.
1. Azalea Park and Recreation Center (CIP 23-750)
 2. La Jolla Recreation Center (CIP 23-513)
 3. Soledad Mountain Park (CIP 23-330)
- C) Park projects not scheduled for any appreciable construction activity in the future which have undergrounding requirements.
1. Balboa Park - Florida Canyon
 2. Colina Del Sol Park and Recreation Center
 3. Lindbergh Park
 4. Mission Bay - Ingraham Street to Vacation Isle
 5. Memorial Park and Recreation Center
 6. Mt. Acadia Park
 7. Mountain View Park
 8. North Park Park and Recreation Center
 9. Olive Grove Park and Recreation Center
 10. San Carlos Park and Recreation Center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution is not adopted as an exercise of the police power of the City to compel relocation underground of overhead electrical facilities at the utility company's expense as set forth in Ordinance No. 10466 (New Series).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the establishment of the priority of projects as set forth above shall not be construed to preclude the City Council from exercising its police power to compel relocation underground of overhead electrical facilities at the utility company's expense if the general health, safety and welfare of the community should so require.
