AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 7,
SECTIONS 27.2804 AND 27.2808, OF THE SAN DIEGO
MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATING TO CHARTER AMENDMENT
INITIATIVE ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 7, Sections 27.2804
and 27.2808, of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and the same
are hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 27.2804 CHARTER AMENDMENT PETITION

The petition for amendments to the City Charter shall
be in the following form:

ment Code of the State of California, present to the
Council of The City of San Diego, this petition and request
that the following proposed amendment to the Charter of
the City be submitted to the registered voters of the
City for their adoption or rejection at an election on a
date to be determined by the Council.
