AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO RULE IV OF THE RULES OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION BY AMENDING SECTION 4, AND AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 5 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 23.0504 RELATING TO EXTENSION OF ELIGIBLE LISTS FOR EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Rule IV of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission and Chapter II, Article 3, Division 5, Section 23.0504 of the San Diego Municipal Code, be and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 23.0504 EXTENSION OF ELIGIBLE LISTS
[Rule IV, Section 4 of the Rules
of the Civil Service Commission]

The City Manager or a department head not under the Manager shall initiate requests for extensions of eligible lists. The Personnel Director shall make recommendations thereupon and forward the request to the Commission. The Commission may extend an eligible list for additional periods. The total time of any such extensions shall not exceed one year. Requests for extension of a list shall be submitted prior to the expiration date of the list.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
