

ORDINANCE NO. 10576 MAY 13 1971
(New Series)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III,
ARTICLE 3 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL
CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 33.1625.2
RELATING TO CARD ROOM LICENSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of The City of
San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 3 of the
San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by
amending Section 33.1625.2 to read as follows:

SEC. 33.1625.2 APPLICATION--CONTENTS--LICENSE
WORK PERMIT

An applicant for a card room license shall
submit his application to the Chief of Police of
The City of San Diego, which application shall be
under oath, and shall include, among other things,
the true names and addresses of all persons
financially interested in the business. Said
application shall also be accompanied by a Fifty
Dollar (\$50.00) nonrefundable investigation fee.
The past criminal record if any of all persons
financially or otherwise interested in the business
shall be shown on such application. The term
"persons financially interested" shall include
all persons who share in the profits of the
business, on the basis of gross or net revenue,
including landlords, lessors, lessees, the owner
or owners of the building, fixtures or equipment.

The application shall also be accompanied by fingerprints of persons financially interested. A license may be issued only to citizens of the United States who have resided in the County of San Diego for at least two (2) years immediately preceding the issuance of such license.

The Chief of Police may deny any applicant for a card room license, a license to operate such card room when in the opinion of the Chief of Police there appears to be good cause why such person should not operate a card room.

Employees in card rooms must obtain a work permit from the Chief of Police; applications for such work permits shall be submitted under oath and contain such information as may be deemed by the Chief of Police necessary to determine whether the applicant is a proper person to be employed in a card room.

No work permit shall be issued to any person who is not a citizen of the United States and who has not been a resident of the County of San Diego for at least one (1) year. The Chief of Police may deny to such applicant a work permit if, in his opinion good cause appears why such person should not be permitted to be employed in a card room. Each

application for a work permit shall be accompanied by a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and said work permit when issued shall be valid for one (1) year.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 3 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 33.1025.2 RELATING TO CARD ROOM LICENSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 3 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by amending Section 33.1025.2 to read as follows:

SEC. 33.1025.2 APPLICATION — CONTENTS — LICENSE WORK PERMIT

An applicant for a card room license shall submit his application to the Chief of Police of The City of San Diego, which application shall be under oath, and shall include, among other things, the true names and addresses of all persons financially interested in the business. Said application shall also be accompanied by a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) nonrefundable investigation fee. The past criminal record if any of all persons financially or otherwise interested in the business shall be shown on such application. The term "persons financially interested" shall include all persons who share in the profits of the business, on the basis of gross or net revenue, including landlords, lessors, lessees, the owner or owners of the building, fixtures or equipment. The application shall also be accompanied by fingerprints of persons financially interested. A license may be issued only to citizens of the United States who have resided in the County of San Diego for at least two (2) years immediately preceding the issuance of such license.

The Chief of Police may deny any applicant for a card room license, a license to operate such card room when in the opinion of the Chief of Police there appears to be good cause why such person should not operate a card room.

Employees in card rooms must obtain a work permit from the Chief of Police; applications for such work permits shall be submitted under oath and contain such information as may be deemed by the Chief of Police necessary to determine whether the applicant is a proper person to be employed in a card room.

No work permit shall be issued to any person who is not a citizen of the United States and who has not been a resident of the County of San Diego for at least one (1) year. The Chief of Police may deny to such applicant a work permit if, in his opinion good cause appears why such person should not be permitted to be employed in a card room. Each application for a work permit shall be accompanied by a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and said work permit when issued shall be valid for one (1) year.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
